Homework Policy

There are three main purposes to homework:

- re-enforcement
- extension
- preparation for future learning

Aims:

This policy outlines the purpose, nature and management of homework within our school.

- 1 The school policy for homework reflects the consensus of opinion of the whole teaching staff. It has been drawn up as a result of staff discussion and has the full agreement of the governing body and teachers.
- 2 The implementation of this policy is the responsibility of all members of teaching staff.

The Nature of Homework

- At our school we expect our pupils to work hard at all times and we realise that children need time for relaxation, after school activities and social interaction with their peers away from the school environment.
- There is also a need to prepare our older pupils for secondary transfer and homework takes on added importance in this preparation.
- We believe that homework develops a regular work routine and should be carefully balanced to bring out an additional opportunity for learning.
- Homework allows parents and carers to become actively involved in their child's education and we value this input.

Organisation

Homework will be given out on Thursdays and set weekly. Copies of the class homework sheet are uploaded onto the school website/ Google Classroom every Thursday.

Review of the homework may form part of lessons.

Pupils not carrying out the homework will first be reminded of its importance. They may also be given time during the school day, but outside of lessons, to complete the tasks.

Key Stage 1 children are encouraged to:

- Read at least three times a week for ten minutes or more
- Complete a spelling activity
- Carry out a Maths and/or Literacy task
- Complete a termly project task

Key Stage 2 children are encouraged to:

- Read at least three times a week for ten minutes or more
- Complete a Literacy task including a focus on spelling
- Carry out a Maths task
- Complete a termly project task

Assessment

The teacher is continually assessing homework. A link with the Home-School Agreement is established.

Review

This policy will be reviewed every 2 years.
